PURPOSE OF WONDERFUL WEDNESDAYS

Wonderful Wednesdays is a ministry provided by Ivor Baptist Church for all children in grades First (may accept Pre-K and Kindergarten) through high school with some older “Assistants” for the purposes of:

- building friendships with peers through games and fun activities;
- learning about God’s love through music, self-expression, and Bible study;
- becoming a disciple of Christ by learning Christian spiritual practices (prayer, study, communion, baptism, etc);
- worshipping God through music and spoken word; and,
- allowing all children, the opportunity to develop a Christian faith that is uniquely their own.

GUIDELINES FOR CHILDREN

1. Check In upon arrival and Check Out when leaving.
2. Walk in church (“inside feet”) at all times.
3. Always stay with your teacher or other staff person.
4. Get permission before leaving your teacher’s site.
5. Remain in your seat while in your classroom.
6. Be quiet when your teacher is talking & raise your hand when you have something to say.

WONDERFUL WEDNESDAYS ROUTINE

1. **SNACK TIME:** Check in. Place your backpack in the hallway, wash your hands, and get a snack. Have a blessing and share prayer requests. Talk and share.
2. **CLEAN UP:** Discard your trash.
3. **BATHROOM AND WATER FOUNTAIN BREAK/S:** Younger children will use the bathroom at the back of the Educational Wing (closest to the nursery) and the older children will use the bathrooms near the entrance to the Educational Wing. No child may leave the group without permission and no child should be outside of the Educational Wing unless under the supervision/direction of a WW staff person.
4. **BIBLE STUDY TIME:** Bible Study time requires good listening skills. Children should show courtesy by raising their hands when they want to speak and by listening to what others have to say. A craft activity may be included in this segment. (Approx. 30 min.)
5. **MUSIC/RECREATION:** Games may be played outside or inside. A bell will ring when it is time for one of these activities to begin. When the bell rings, children will line up quietly at the door and quietly follow their teacher to where the activity/music will take place. (Approx. 30 min.)
